CAUTION! Stones Ahead is the Shoals' newest must-see museum experience, joining legendary musical landmarks like FAME Recording Studios and Muscle Shoals Sound Studio.

The exhibition showcases iconic Rolling Stones memorabilia — from rare vintage posters to one-of-a-kind, stage-worn artifacts — highlighted by a massive, tour-used 9-foot-tall, 2,000-pound Tongue & Lips tour prop that promises to be the ultimate photo opportunity.

This display serves as the world's largest public exhibition of memorabilia dedicated to the Rolling Stones.

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FOUNDER & FOUNDATION

This collection is the lifelong passion of collector Gentry Allen. Born in Nashville, Tennessee, with deep family roots in the Shoals, he proudly considers the area his “second hometown.” The collection has been sourced from around the world.

Having attended more than 30 Rolling Stones concerts worldwide, Gentry views this exhibition as the culmination of art, music, and preservation. He also serves as the museum's curator.

The collection has been donated to the Gentry Allen Art & Music Foundation, a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. The Foundation's mission is to preserve significant cultural artifacts, educate the public about the music that shapes our world, and inspire individuals of all ages and backgrounds to find their place in the arts.



LOCATION

The museum is housed within the Renaissance Shoals Resort & Spa in Florence, Alabama. While no definitive closing date has been announced, **CAUTION! Stones Ahead** is planned as a long-term exhibition and a signature feature of the resort experience.

Located just a 10-minute drive from the historic Muscle Shoals Sound Studio — where the Rolling Stones recorded three tracks for the iconic *Sticky Fingers* album in 1969 — the exhibition stands at the heart of one of America's most legendary music regions.



GRAND OPENING!

CAUTION! Stones Ahead will officially open with a grand opening concert featuring Chanel Haynes and Tim Ries, both established members of the Rolling Stones touring band. The evening's performance will include selections from the Rolling Stones catalog, Muscle Shoals classics, and solo material.

Following the concert, guests are invited to a VIP grand opening reception inside the exhibition — the world's largest public display of Rolling Stones memorabilia.
